Plenary panel of UN and political leaders discuss prevention of violent extremism



During the Opening Ceremony of the 7th UNAOC Global Forum yesterday, leaders of the host government, the United Nations, and the co-sponsors of the United Nations Alliance of Civilizations made vigorous points for facilitating inclusive societies and jointly preventing violent extremism.

"Many years of experience have proven that heavy-handed approaches and a single-minded focus only on

security measures have failed. We must pay particular attention to addressing the causes of violent extremism', said UNAOC High Representative Al-Nasser. He emphasized UNAOC's approach as a "soft power" tool, promoting dialogue as a crucial mean to overcome divides and prevent extremism.

In his speech, the President of Azerbaijan, Ilham Aliyev, emphasized the long history of multiculturalism in Azerbaijan: "Religious tolerance and multiculturalism were always present here. The term may not have existed, but the idea always has." Turkish President Erdogan stressed that "terror and terrorism have nothing in common with Islam", while Spanish Minister of Foreign Affairs Garcia-Margallo noted that: "most of the victims of violent extremism are Muslims"

"In a world of suspicion and fear, the Alliance is forging trust and understanding. Its projects support young innovators, provides resources for journalists and honor leaders who encourage dialogues."

During the first plenary session on Tuesday afternoon, high-level political and UN officials explored the context of preventing violent extremism. "It is impossible to work on peace and security without interreligious dialogue", said Jean-Paul Laborde, Executive Director of the Counter-Terrorism Executive Directorate of the UN. Former Spanish Prime Minister Zapatero stressed that addressing the root causes to violent extremism is key to preventing and countering it.

All leaders called for a strong and global partnership to address the prevention of violent extremism, considering the United Nations' leading role. Former French Prime Minister de Villepin gave a reality check saying that we are losing the battle against terrorism. He praised The New Silk Road Initiative, describing it as the only global vision today as it creates growth for more stability.
